



## Graphics Technician

### The Company

The Technical and Environmental Services department requires a Graphics Technician to join them, to create, produce, and manage, the delivery of a range of graphics and illustrations to support the development of a wide variety of projects.

- Producing complex constraints plans for proposed sites to assist the layout and design of development.
- Developing and maintaining an in-depth knowledge of relevant guidance and best practice in place at a national, regional, and local level to ensure the graphics are produced in line with specific requirements.
- Coordinating and managing of the landscape figures and graphics for a portfolio of projects within set deadlines.
- Working closely with other GCR departments to provide a holistic approach to site design and development.
